## Sanitary District No. 2 Meeting Minutes – APPROVED

**Present:** Sanitary District Commissioners Tim Ehler and John Sterling (online); Administrator Christina Peterson, and Water Operator Dan Odeen

1. Regular meeting called to order by Ehler at 4:35 p.m.
2. Minutes from 02/26/2026. Motion by Sterling to approve minutes from 02/26/2026, second by Ehler. Motion carried unanimously.
3. Bills Payable. Motion by Sterling to pay open invoices in the amount of \$4,638.81, second by Ehler. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Sterling to approve closed invoices in the amount of \$29,729.29, second by Ehler, Motion carried unanimously
4. Public Comment. None.
5. Arbor Hills Lift Station Generator – Updated quote is \$33,000. Pumps run about 2 hours a week. Ehler and Odeen thought getting another portable generator may be a better value. Only 2 lift stations are wired for a generator... Arbor Hills and Floral Ln. Southdale and Hillcrest lift stations serve customers that have private wells. Odeen mentioned that rentals are always an option. In 12 years, Arbor Hills maybe had one power outage to affect the lift station. One time prior to 12 years there was an extended power outage which caused a sewer back up. Sterling asked about testing the generator and Odeen responded that they run once a month. Staff were directed to get quotes for a portable generator.
6. Administrator Report. A congressional funding request was submitted to Congressman Van Orden and to Senator Baldwin's office.
7. Public Works Report. Odeen sent PFAs test samples off for Arbor Hills and Skyline. Sanitary Survey from DNR will be conducted appointment with DNR is April 2. He will discuss discontinuing Fluoride. Ehler asked about sewer lining. More televising will be scheduled. Arbor Hills connection is high priority, but it is not conducive to lining due to access issues. Portions may need to be rebuilt.

10. Adjournment. Motion by Sterling to adjourn at 5:08 second by Ehler. Motion carried unanimously.
