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Sanitary District No. 2 Meeting Minutes – **APPROVED**

Present: Sanitary District Commissioners Tim Ehler, Geno Francis and John Sterling (via Teams); Administrator Christina Peterson, and Water Operator Dan Odeen

1. Regular meeting called to order by Ehler at 4:36p.m.
2. Minutes from 05/21/2026. Motion by Francis to approve minutes from 05/21/2026, second by Sterling . Motion carried unanimously.
3. Bills Payable. Motion by Francis to approve open and closed invoices in the amount of \$50,539.49 and \$2,484.17 respectively, second by Sterling. Motion carried unanimously.
4. Public Comment. None
5. Old Business – Fluoride. Odeen reported his testing results on fluoride. Arbor Hills and Wedgewood had 0.1 residual natural fluoride. Skyline had 0.2 – 0.3 residual natural fluoride. Ehler suggested deciding on July meeting after a notice is given on water bills.
6. New Business – Rehab of Skyline Well. Review of proposal from Municipal Well for pump replacement. System can only be down for a few days, so planning for December when there is less water usage is best. Mailing will go out to 63 homes to conserve water during the rehabilitation project. Odeen can also place message board. Motion by Francis to approve proposal and fees up to \$38,099.50, second by Sterling. Motion carried unanimously.
7. New Business – Cleaning and inspection of Wedgwood Valley and Arbor Hills reservoirs. Review of a \$6,400.00 proposal from Water Tower Clean and Coat for cleaning reservoirs. The cleaning is typically done every five years. Arbor Hills will be at 3 years. Motion by Francis, second by Sterling to approve. Motion carried unanimously.
8. Public Works.
 - a) Odeen reported that the water truck (2014, 120,000 miles) needed a repair to exhaust valve.
 - b) Received bottles for remainder of testing from Northern Lakes Testing. The testing will be the annual testing plus lead and copper which is due every three years.
 - c) Water expo in Plover, WI. August 27, 2026. Dan, Chris, Eric and Christina will attend.
9. Administrator Report. Arbor Hills Filtration. The funding request passed appropriations committee for 1.1 million, which is first step in congressional approval. Project total estimate is 3 million.
