1. Meeting called to order by Chairperson Tim Candahl at 5:02 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.
2. Minutes from 10/15/19 meeting reviewed, Padesky motion to approve, second by Knutson. Motion carried unanimously.
3. Minutes from 10/29/19 meeting reviewed, Knutson motion to approve, second by Heal. Motion carried unanimously.
4. Citizen Concerns. Nelson property that was purchased by Shelby in the last year or so was hutable when it was privately owned. Citizen was inquiring as to whether the town would grant special permission or establish a permit system to allow bow hunting in that area at certain times. Another citizen suggested using a similar signage system as Onalaska uses for Greens Coulee to warn hikers/ general public about hunting. Board unanimously agreed to table the issue while they conduct research and discuss the issue further.
5. Administrator's Report. (See Report Attached)
 - a. Captain Travis Proksch gave additional information regarding the Fire Department including an update on the new truck which will arrive in six weeks. He stated 90% of equipment for the truck has been purchased. Candahl mentioned officers will have a committee to discuss the placement of trucks and will bring back recommendations to the Town Board. Proksch gave the date for upcoming Game Feed to be on February 10th. He said department is working on inspection list and will be contracting with Fire Inspection Services.
