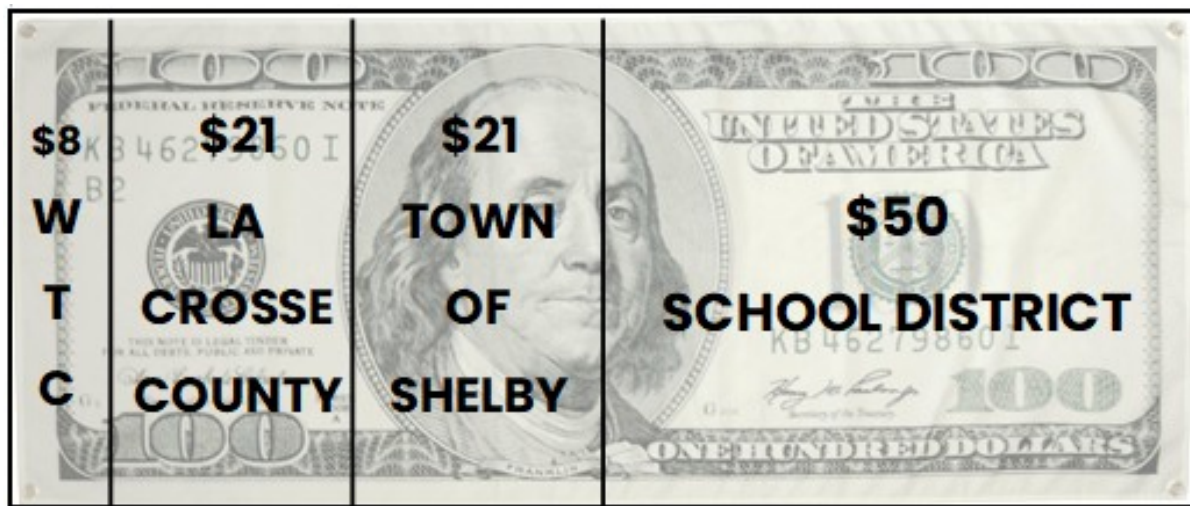


WHERE DO YOUR TAX DOLLARS GO?

Tax time is approaching and we are preparing to send tax bills soon. Often residents ask us, "where do my taxes go?". Below is a very basic breakdown of how every \$100.00 worth of taxes collected is distributed.

**This breakdown does not include things like, special assessments, special charges (i.e. garbage), or any additional levy or referenda (i.e. school district referenda).*

(Check or Cash ONLY)

BY MAIL
(Check ONLY)



SENDING TAXES BY MAIL? YOU NEED TO KNOW THIS!

Residents that send in their payments close to the due date (Jan. 31) may rely on the envelope being postmarked to be accepted as "on time". Recent changes in the USPS Rules state the local post office will only postmark envelopes when asked to do so by the sender.

Envelopes placed in a Post Office Box or sent from home will be post marked when received at the regional processing facility (aka Minneapolis, Milwaukee, etc.). This can delay the post mark by around 3 days from the date it was originally sent.
