### Town of Shelby Received a Grant for the Relocation and Upgrade of Shelby Fire Station No. 1

The Town was awarded \$252,000.00 through the Wisconsin Non-State Grant Program.

The funds will be used towards the first phase of this project to purchase a larger, existing building and make the code required updates.

In addition to improvements for the Fire Department, the relocation will give the Town more options for other operations including improved space for elections, public works storage, safer parking and combined office space for Town Administration and Public Works.

"The updated facility will greatly increase our ability to service residents by maintaining our fleet and assets. The project will also allow for a larger training space for staff." - Chief Holinka

### NEW! Automatic Payments on Utility Bills - Sanitary District No. 2

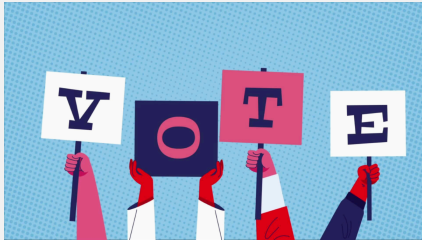
