NEW BUILDING INSPECTOR



REMINDER:

SUMMER HOURS

Town Hall will be open Monday – Thursday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and on Fridays from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. (noon). These hours will be in effect June 1st to September 4th.

Additionally, the Town of Shelby Road Crew will be working 10 hour days, Monday – Thursday. These hours will be in effect until Fall.



BRUSH PICKUP

Spring Cleaning means we start seeing brush piles appearing on the side of the road. Brush pickup dates remaining for 2023 are: **May 17-18, June 28-29, July 26-27, August 23-24, September 20-21, October 18-19, November 15-16.**

As always, you can request a pickup by calling 608-788-1032 x1 or by sending an email to info@townofshelby.com. You must make your request before 4:00 p.m. on the Tuesday before the brush pickup.

Piles larger than 4'x4'x8' will need to be handled by a private tree service or be taken to the La Crosse County Landfill. No exceptions.

Please stack your brush neatly on your front lawn with the cut ends facing the street.

REMINDER—brush burning permits are free from the Fire Department if your brush pile is too large for pickup or if you cannot hire a private service.



LARGE ITEM DROP OFF

This service will only be available from 7:00 a.m. to noon on the following dates in 2023: May 13, June 10, August 12, September 9, October 14, and November 11.

FIREWORKS

It is illegal to purchase or use fireworks within the Town of Shelby without obtaining a permit. Permits must be applied for at Town Hall and will be reviewed by the Town Board for approval.

Absolutely no fireworks are allowed in Town Parks, no exceptions.

SHELBY FIRE DEPARTMENT - REMINDER ABOUT HOME SAFETY

The Shelby Fire Department wants to remind senior residents to take simple steps to keep themselves safe at home.

- 1) Make sure you remove trip hazards such as loose cords, rugs and clutter.
- 2) Always carry a mobile phone or lifeline button to ensure you can call for help.
- 3) Stay hydrated, avoid alcohol.
- 4) Eat regularly to avoid low blood sugar.

- 5) Take medications as prescribed.
- 6) Get checkups regularly.
- 7) Wear non slip shoes.
- 8) Add nightlights in poorly lit areas.
